Research Work

Dissertation

"Management of metacarpal and phalangeal fractures of hand by double intramedullary K wires"

This study was conducted on 25 patients of metacarpal and phalangeal fractures of hand admitted in Department of Orthopaedics, Government Medical College Amritsar between September 2011 to September 2013.

They were treated with percutaneous joint sparing double intramedullary k wires. Evaluation of the result was done according to the Strickland's criteria as excellent, good, fair or poor based on TAM score. In this study 23 cases (92%) were having result good to excellent. 2 cases (8%) were having fair results and none of the cases had poor results.

This study concluded that both Kirschner's wire and mini-fragment plating were good methods of internal fixation in fractures of metacarpal and phalanges though patients who were treated with mini-fragment plating had better results, but the difference was not statistically significant.
